Footnotes

FORMAL RUSH drifted out into the first turn, angled in and stalked inside, moved up along the rail on the second turn, swung out nearing the stretch to gain

the lead, inched away in the drive and won clear under some urging and good handling. TRICK A CAT chased off the rail or outside a rival, split horses leaving the second turn and again in the stretch and edged a rival for the place toward the inside. MARK SET GO angled in and chased inside, came out into the stretch and just got the show three deep on the line. LADY ELIZABETH chased outside then three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and just lost third between foes late. READY MAID chased outside a rival then three wide on the second turn, was forced four wide into the stretch and finished with some interest. SWEET SPOT (GB) chased between rivals then outside a foe, split horses again in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. VELVETY SMOOTH saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and was not a threat. POWER DU JOUR pulled a bit then settled outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked a rally, then did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. SIX CENTS OF HUMOR pulled her way along to duel inside, inched clear into the second turn and weakened in the stretch. KEY ROSE (IRE) angled in and dueled outside a rival, stalked off the rail on the second turn then outside the winner, took up sharply and came out off that one's heels nearing the stretch and weakened. ACID (NZ) chased between horses then a bit off the rail, angled in leaving the second turn and also weakened. A claim of foul by the rider of the runner-up against the winner for alleged interference on the second turn was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the videotape failed to substantiate the claim. Another claim of foul by the rider of KEY ROSE against the winner at the same point was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the incident did not alter that runner's original finish position.
