SQUEEZE ME TIGHT stalked outside a rival then off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and rallied under urging to gain the lead outside foes in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. STEELIN' close up tracking the leader inside, bid along the rail on the hill, put a head in front briefly, continued inside in the stretch and came back on in deep stretch. MACADAMIA sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, dueled outside the runner-up on the hill, inched away into the stretch, fought back between horses in deep stretch and was outfinished. KALOOKAN YEAR was in a good position stalking the pace three deep, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. PETITE CHERIE (IRE) well placed stalking the leader inside to the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. LADY IN LOVE chased between horses down the hill, came out in the stretch and weakened. SEASONS (FR) broke a bit slowly, pulled her way along off the rail and steadied at the right hand curve, went four wide on the hill and three deep into the stretch and did not rally. Rail on hill at zero.
