**Footnotes**

SIR HAMILTON was quickly sent to the front, set pressured pace while bit off the fence to the bend, edged away into the stretch, drifted out slightly late and gamely held. MEADOW ROAD settled early while crossing over, chased along the fence, rallied on the rail into and through the stretch and gained second. BLAKE stalked along the rail early, angled off the fence on the turn, came two wide into lane and bested others. MANNAK gained forward position, tracked pace early, moved up three wide on the turn, was fanned four wide exiting the turn and finished evenly. MAGIC BEAM was squeezed back at the start, lagged back early, saved ground to the turn, angled in some, then came back out and finished strongly. BACK AT YOU chased from between rivals, continued two then three wide to the stretch and lacked needed response. GOTHICS PEAK broke inward, widest of all chasing the pace to the turn, continued four wide around the bend and failed to threaten. LINCECUM stalked on two wide path into and on the turn, dropped back in upper stretch and weakened. CENTENARIO DE ORO forced the early issue outside winner, stalked pace into and around the turn then weakened. YOU KNOW WE KNOW was forced in bit leaving the gate, also chased from the outside, came three wide into the lane and faded.
