DEMOCRAT DUCK chased inside, came out into the stretch and bumped a rival, then rallied between foes under some left handed urging to get up late. APOSTLE PAUL bobbled at the start, chased outside a rival, was forced three deep then four wide into the stretch and bumped by the winner in upper stretch, then finished willingly outside. BENEDICT AUDREY angled in and stalked off the rail, bid alongside a rival to duel for the lead on the backstretch and second turn, took the advantage in the stretch, inched away and held on well but was caught late. LEMON DROP DREAM stalked inside, came out a bit into the stretch and was outfinished. PERFECT SET forced out into the first turn, angled in and chased outside a rival to the stretch, was forced in some when between foes in deep stretch and could not offer the needed late kick. NOBLE POWER (IRE) angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and our wide into the stretch and found his best stride late. FAR ROCKAWAY stalked outside a rival then between foes, came three deep into the stretch, drifted in some when between rivals, in deep stretch and lacked the necessary rally. ANCIENT STONE broke in then came out onto a rival, angled in and sped to the lead, dueled inside on the backstretch and second turn, drifted out a bit in deep stretch and weakened. COOL ROGER saved ground chasing the pace, came off the rail in the stretch, took up sharply in very tight off heels a sixteenth out and could not recover. SECRET WISHES was bumped and clipped heels just after the start, settled inside then a bit off the rail, angled in on the second turn, came out in the stretch, was in tight off heels a sixteenth from the wire and lacked the needed rally. KINGS GIANT forced out and steadied into the first turn, chased outside, came three deep into the

stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. CACAU squeezed at the start, pulled between horses then steadied sharply off heels into the first turn, tugged his way up three deep on the backstretch to stalk the pace, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run but made no change when they ruled the bumping between the top pair did not alter the original order of finish and the trouble to COOL ROGER was caused by FAR ROCKAWAY.
