LAZY SLUSAN stalked the pace outside a rival, bid three deep into and on the second turn and through the stretch and gamely prevailed under urging. SPAIN had speed between horses early, angled in on the first turn and dueled along the rail throughout, fought back gamely in the stretch but could not quite contain the winner. CRITIKOLA (ARG) saved ground close up stalking the leaders to the stretch, came out in upper stretch and closed willingly late. FEVERISH sped to the early lead three deep into the first turn, dueled outside the runner-up on that bend and on the backstretch, continued between foes into and on the second turn and through the stretch, fought back in the drive but was outfinished. GOURMET GIRL pulled a bit under a long hold early, settled off the rail then outside rivals, came a bit wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late response. LOVELLON (ARG) settled a bit off the rail, split horses leaving the backstretch, came out into the stretch, then angled in and also could not summon the needed late kick. LET'S CRUISE (NZ) pulled along the inside and steadied into the first turn, saved ground, dropped back leaving the backstretch and gave way.
