CENTEROFATTENTION stalked the pace three deep, bid outside the leader on the turn, took a short lead nearing midstretch and pulled clear under left handed urging. IMAGINARY GOLD chased outside on the backstretch and four wide on the turn and into the stretch, was no match for the winner but held off a foe for second. FAST GOAT close up stalking along the inside, came out in deep stretch, and split rivals late to just miss the place. SOTOGRADE sped to the early lead outside, angled in and set the pace off the rail, battled inside the winner on the turn and until past midstretch, then weakened. DIAMOND EMBLEM came off the rail early, split horses into the turn, continued four wide on the bend and into the stretch and lacked the needed response. DEVLISH stalked the leader a bit off the rail or between horses, angled in leaving the turn and weakened. QUICK NIP pulled between foes and was in tight early, began climbing and steadied behind rivals midway on the backstretch, went up between foes into tight quarters again into the turn, continued three deep and also weakened. CARYATID broke in and bumped the runner-up, chased five wide on the backstretch and into the turn, angled in leaving the bend and gave way.
