Footnotes

SNOWFLAKE (IRE) chased outside, moved up five wide on the second turn, bid four wide into the stretch, ranged up outside the pacesetter in midstretch, gained a short lead in deep stretch and gamely prevailed under some urging. KABYLIA (IRE) broke slowly, angled in and settled a bit off the rail then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, went four wide on the second turn and into the stretch and closed willingly to just miss. STOP THE TALKING sped to the early lead and duelled inside, inched away leaving the second turn, fought back inside the winner in the final furlong but could not quite match the top pair late. I'M THE BUSINESS (NZ) settled outside a rival, went between horses into the second turn, waited a bit in traffic on that bend, came out three deep into the stretch and finished well. AMERICAN CZARINA chased outside, advanced four wide on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, drifted in some in the drive and lacked the needed late kick. MPENZI settled inside off the pace, moved up on the second turn, steadied off heels into the stretch, came out and found her best stride late. LAND TAX chased a bit off the rail, went between horses on the second turn and waited briefly, steadied in tight in midstretch and could not offer the needed rally. SINGLE HONOUR (GB) pulled along the inside early, moved up into the second turn, waited a bit on that bend, came out in midstretch and also lacked the needed response. LUNA NEGRA (IRE) chased outside, launched a bid three deep on the second turn and between horses into the stretch, then weakened. BOLD ROBERTA pulled her way along inside to stalk the pace, was shuffled a bit leaving the second turn and weakened. BLUE SPRINGS close up between horses then a bit off the rail stalking the pace, dropped back on the second turn and had little left. YES WE DO angled in and duelled outside a rival, dropped back fast on the second turn and gave way readily.
