CHANEL ISLANDS was off slow and bit inward, recovered and chased pace from just off the rail, angled out, then drifted out crossing the dirt, five wide into the lane, closed from outside, gained front and held under urging. SPIRITED was off alertly but settled off the leaders and bit off the rail, continued inside to the stretch, came out slightly, split foe, closed stoutly and narrowly missed from inside winner. ALL AGLOW forced pace outside foe, continued alongside pacesetter into the lane, challenged between foes and inside runner-up and finished willingly. SPRING FESTIVAL tracked the leaders while from just off the rail, saved ground into the stretch but weakened slightly in deep stretch. DIS MISS was sent to the front and set a pressured pace from just off the fence down the hill, maintained slim advantage in upper stretch but also weakened through the drive. SMOKEGETENYOUREYES reserved off the rail, came out for room, raced five wide crossing the dirt, came out further into the stretch and failed to menace from the outside. KREEKER chased while outside foe most of the way down the hill, raced four wide into the lane failed to threaten. SMOKIN' VIGOR close up early while outside rival, dropped back bit and wide into the stretch and failed to rally. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
