RUNAWAY WILDCAT had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and through a long drive and gamely prevailed under urging. MONTELLANO dueled between horses on the backstretch and outside the winner on the turn, also fought back through a stiff drive and continued willingly to the end. CALL ME LATER between horses early, stalked off the rail then inside leaving the backstretch and on the turn, came out into the stretch and bested the others. GOT MILCH prompted the pace three deep between horses, stalked off the rail or between foes on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. MAZARRON bobbled slightly at the start, settled off the rail, came out into the stretch, drifted to the inside in the drive and lacked the needed late kick. TAPPIN TOUGH forced the pace four wide on the backstretch, stalked outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened.
