ACHILLES settled off the pace inside, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up on the wire. NO SILENT pulled between horses then chased inside, bid between horses in the stretch, put a head in front past midstretch and continued willingly to the wire. BROTHER FRANCIS a step slow to begin, settled outside a rival, moved up three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch, gained a short advantage three wide in midstretch, fought back between horses in late stretch and also went on gamely to the end. LATE NIGHT SKY had speed three deep then dueled outside a rival, kicked clear and angled in on the backstretch, opened up some past the half mile pole, fought back in midstretch and weakened late. A DAY AWAY stalked the pace inside, split rivals into the stretch, steadied briefly in a bit tight nearing the eighth pole and also weakened. SOLID SOUTH chased outside a rival, came out on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked a rally. MR PAPPAGIORGIO pulled between horses then dueled inside a rival, stalked along the rail on the backstretch, dropped back between horses on the second turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
