Footnotes

DEPRECIABLE had speed a bit off the rail then stalked between horses, angled in on the hill, came out off heels in midstretch and closed willingly under some urging and good handling to get up three deep late. STORMBERG chased just off the inside then saved ground on the hill, came out past the eighth pole, took a short lead in deep stretch and was caught between foes late. KUMIVA had speed four wide then stalked outside or off the rail, came out some into the stretch, gained the lead and drifted in a bit nearing midstretch, fought back inside in deep stretch and held third. SILVER SPUR (AUS) chased outside then four wide, continued three deep leaving the hill and into the stretch, was forced out in midstretch and was outfinished. MR. MAKE BELIEVE a step slow to begin, went up between horses to chase the pace, came out some in the stretch, steadied behind the winner and was forced out some in midstretch and lacked the needed late kick. TRIBAL NATION pulled early, chased outside then tugged his way between foes, continued alongside a rival leaving the hill, came three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary rally. DON PERICO sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, was between horses in upper stretch and a bit crowded when KUMIVA went by, then weakened. KING LEDLEY broke a bit slowly, saved ground chasing the pace to the stretch and lacked the needed rally. LE MANS chased between foes then outside a rival, swung out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. KILLER BEAR dropped back off the rail then angled in on the hill and was not a threat. Following a stewards' inquiry and a claim of foul by the rider of MR. MAKE BELIEVE against the winner for alleged interference in midstretch, no change was made when they ruled the incident did not alter the original order of finish. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
