TRAWEEK close up stalking the pace inside to the stretch, bid along the rail past the eighth pole, gained the advantage a sixteenth out and gamely prevailed under urging. BANGED HIS EYE stalked three deep then off the rail on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, bid outside a pair of foes past midstretch and continued willingly but was outgamed. SOI PHET was in a good position stalking the pace outside then alongside a rival on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and found his best stride late. VALEN chased off the rail then inside leaving the backstretch, came out on the turn and again into the stretch, angled in some in the drive, split foes in deep stretch and lacked the needed rally. BROADWAY NIKA stalked between horses then a bit off the rail on the turn, continued inside in the stretch and could not offer the needed late kick. EATON HALL sped to the early lead, set the pace on a clear advantage a bit off the rail, was between foes a sixteenth out and weakened. MINISTER OF TRADE a half step slow into stride, settled just off the rail then inside, came out on the turn and again into the stretch and was not a threat. SONOFTOKAYANA broke in and bumped a rival, settled outside then alongside a foe on the turn and did not rally. NARANJO sent between horses early, chased a bit off the rail then angled in on the turn, cut the corner into the stretch and lacked the necessary response. OUTPERFORM bumped and steadied when squeezed at the start, settled off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and was outrun.
