PACIFIC OCEAN SONG content to stalk the pacesetter from the inside to the second turn, came off the fence, drifted out in upper stretch and then drifted out again under left hand pressure while a bit green, but was straightened away and overhauled leader nearing wire. SUNETTE sped to the front and opened a clear cushion into the backstretch, maintained lead into the lane but could not stave off winner late. KAYDARA saved ground chasing the pace, came out slightly in upper stretch and gamely held the show. SKIP'S GAL three deep into the initial turn, continued well off rail and outside foe chasing the leader, raced three wide into the stretch and failed to menace. SEEKING RESULTS reserved from along the rail, continued to save ground into the stretch and finished evenly. HOPE'S TRIUMPH between foes early and then unhurried from the inside, swung out on second turn, was three wide leaving that bend and outrun.
