ARCHIE'S DREAM prominent from along the rail early, dropped back a bit on the turn, swung out and was three wide entering the stretch, responded when roused, then surged past pacesetter and accelerated away under urging. IAMATOWERTOOClose up while between rivals early, remained a bit off the rail and finished willingly to gain the place. HOT MESSAGE bumped by inside foe at the break but quickly recovered and sped to the front, maintained cushion from inside into the stretch but weakened and lost placing. REFUSAL was off slow, gradually angled out through the backstretch, caught three wide into the turn and then four wide leaving that bend while never menacing. ELK MOUNTAIN reserved while angling over and then finding the fence, later came back out, chased outside foe and was no factor. HESTOOOCLEVER broke out and bumped foe leaving the gate, settled off the leaders, saved ground but lacked any stretch response. KENNEBEC lagged far back while angling in some, continued inside and was outrun. MR. WISTER close up while three deep, remained on same path around the bend and gave way readily in the stretch.
