**Footnotes**

MY FRIEND LUIS unhurried down the backstretch, entered the stretch four wide to circle the field, took the lead inside the furlong marker and held sway. COMMON TRUST chased the leaders three wide down the backstretch, entered the lane three wide to take the lead, was outfinished but was a clear second. COLONEL COURTNEY sped immediately to the early lead from the outside, angled over and dueled on the inside into the lane, battled gamely down the stretch to hold third. FORD ISLAND pressed the leader from the outside down the backstretch, continued to battle that rival down the lane and was nodded at the wire for third. WINESHINE rushed up on the inside down the backstretch, continued on the rail on the turn and in the lane, was unable to angle out down the lane and finished evenly. CAPTAIN SACTO hopped a bit at the start to be away slowly, was between horses entering the turn, angled out for the drive, but lacked a sufficient rally.
