Footnotes

ME SALTY chased the pace inside a rival down the backstretch,saved ground around the turn, came off the rail leaving the turn, bid for the lead leaving the furlong marker and drew clear under steady urging. AMERICAN WILDCAT sped to the early lead between horses, showed the way inside down the backstretch and around the turn, gave up command leaving the furlong marker, could not keep pace with the winner but held the place. CUT FASTBALL broke in and bumped a rival at the start, pressed the pace on the outside down the backstretch, came into the lane three wide and weakened in the final furlong. THUNDER OF ZION was bumped between horses at the start, chased the pace outside the winner down the backstretch, came into the stretch four wide, remained in the middle of the track through the final furlong and weakened. LIME ROCK REVENGE chased on the outside throughout the journey and did not mount a rally. RUNAWAY WILDCAT bobbled at the start, chased on the inside then a bit off the rail, came out for the stretch drive and was no threat in the lane.
