CAPTURE THE CALL had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back when headed in the stretch, regained the advantage under urging, inched away some in deep stretch and held on gamely. LOW GEAR POWER chased a bit off the rail, came out four wide passing the quarter pole and three deep into the stretch, drifted in some in the drive but closed willingly to just miss. MAN CHESTER MAN dueled between horses then outside the winner on the second turn, put a head in front in the stretch, fought back past midstretch, could not quite match the top pair late but clearly bested the others. KWIK a bit slow to begin, settled off the rail chasing the pace, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BATTLE POINT broke slowly, went up four wide into and on the first turn, stalked off the rail, angled in between horses into the stretch and weakened. ELUSIVE SCHEMES stalked a bit off the rail then inside to the stretch and also weakened. RAINGEAR three deep between horses into the first turn, dueled three deep, fell back some on the second turn, dropped back between horses nearing the stretch and had little left for the drive. A BIG TO'DO pulled early, chased a bit off the rail, came out some on the backstretch, dropped well back, was pulled up leaving the second turn and vanned off.
