Footnotes

TIMES GONE BY between foes early, stalked inside, came off the rail on the second turn, was fanned four wide into the stretch, bid three deep in midstretch, gained the lead past the eighth pole, inched away under urging in deep stretch and held. JAIRZIHNO (GB) a bit slow to begin, was between horses then angled in and chased inside, came out into the stretch, angled out onto a rival in midstretch and rallied willingly to just miss. THEY CALL HIM EL ducked in sharply to be away slowly, saved ground off the pace, inched forward in the stretch, came out in deep stretch and split rivals late for third. VICTORIAN PRINCE (IRE) stumbled at the start, went up inside to stalk the pace, bid along the rail in the stretch and was outfinished in the final sixteenth. DOUBLE SHUFFLE broke slowly, chased in traffic between horses to the stretch, was bumped, steadied and forced out in midstretch but finished with interest three deep on the line. SPECIAL KID had good early speed and angled in, dueled inside, inched away off the rail into the stretch, was between

horses in midstretch and weakened late. SANDOR (GB) angled in and settled outside a rival, came out in upper stretch, angled in off heels in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. LUMBERYARD JACK veered out sharply to be away slowly, went up outside then stalked three deep, came five wide into the stretch and did not rally. SYNCOBEAT angled in and dueled outside a rival, fell back some while being floated out a bit into the stretch, was bumped between foes in midstretch and weakened. MARK THE BENCH angled in and stalked the pace outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and also weakened. Following a claim of foul by the rider of DOUBLE SHUFFLE against the runner-up, the stewards disqualified the latter and placed him fifth for interference in midstretch.
