Footnotes

THATSWHATIMEAN content to stalk leaders from along the rail, shifted out entering the stretch, responded from strong left hand pressure through drive and overhauled inside rivals. CEE'S IRISH was sent to front and rated from just off the fence, resisted when challenged leaving last turn, battled back under vigorous handling from inside and narrowly missed. ON LONDON TIME bobbled slightly in initial strides while breaking inward, saved ground chasing the pace, angled out in upper stretch and finished very willingly from outside to garner the show. NORTHERN MISCHIEF pressed the pace outside rival to the second turn, challenged and gained brief lead passing midstretch but gave ground grudgingly late between rivals and lost placing. MASHINA (GB) was off a bit slow and squeezed back, content to lag back while saving ground, continued inside and improved placing. CONVEYOR'S ANGEL chased outside foe through opening half, swung out and caught four wide into the stretch and lacked an effective late response. HOT ATTRACTION stalked a bit off the rail and outside winner, came out further leaving last bend and weakened.
