Footnotes

PLEASANT THUNDER void of early foot while angling in some, chased three wide around the turn, then swung out six wide into the stretch and closed furiously from far outside to be along in time. MUDDY HALO bumped at the break, advanced three wide on the bend, then four wide into the stretch, gained the front but could not stave off winner. SCORESEARLYGALE flashed good early foot, dueled from along the rail and battled gamely through the stretch. GOING ON AGAIN chased from along the rail, shifted out leaving the turn, was five wide into the stretch and lugged out late. RENTS DUE bumped at the start, pressed the pace three deep, battled between foes on the turn, checked in tight quarters leaving that turn and weakened. MON MIEL forced the pace from the outside early, three wide around the turn, engaged the leader into the lane, gained slim lead in midstretch but weakened. ASESINA broke out, was forwardly placed while a bit off the rail, later drifted out leaving the the turn failed to menace. QUIET FLYER reserved from the inside, shifted out and chased four wide into the lane and was no factor. HAINESOME GAL chased from the outside and three wide around the bend, then was fanned out entering the

stretch and lacked any response. SAN MIGUEL RIVER was squeezed and forced to steady at the start, received a ground-saving trip but to no avail. PROUD RETREAT forced the early pace from between rivals, dropped back and weakened.
