MADEO patiently handled from off the rail, continued three wide into second turn, swung out five wide exiting that bend, inhaled inside rivals, surged to the front, then cleared while drifting in some late. SKY CAPE moved up three wide on first turn, pressed the pace while outside rival, moved up and challenged between rivals into the lane, gained brief lead, could not match the winner but held second. SAFETY ZONE lagged back while bit off the fenced, swung out second turn, caught four wide into the stretch and rallied from the outside for third. MONTEREY JAZZ bobbled slightly leaving the gate, settled between foes then chased outside rival, bid three deep exiting the second turn, lugged inward through the drive and lost placing late. MEN'S MAGAZINE (ITY) angled over and chased the pace while slightly off the fence, between foes and inside winner on second turn, then lacked needed late punch. MAST TRACK gained forward position inside, hugged the rail to the stretch and lacked needed response. PORTO SANTO (FR) unhurried while taken to the fence, chased inside into the lane, came out later but failed to threaten. YACHT SPOTTER was off alertly and quickly shot to front while crossing over, dictated pace from the inside, was collared entering the lane and gave way inside.
