Footnotes

HOME SWEET ASPEN pressed the pace three deep into the turn, remained outside a three horse spread around the turn, came into the lane three wide, took command in midstretch and edged clear in the final furlong while under hand urging in the late stages. MIZDIRECTION broke out at the start and bumped a rival, stalked behind the three horse duel into the turn, saved some ground around the turn, swung outside for the stretch drive and gained the place. TEMPTATION BOUND chased off the rail down the backstretch and around the turn, came out widest in the lane and was up for the show in the late stages. TUESDAYS WITH P pressed the pace between horses into and around the turn and gradually weakened between foes in the final furlong while drifting in. SHOO GEE sped to the early lead, dueled on the inside into and around the turn and weakened on the rail through the final furlong and steadied in tight a sixteenth out. PINK BLANKET was bumped and steadied between horses at the start, recovered to move up on the outside down the backstretch and around the turn, came into the stretch four wide and lacked the necessary rally. SOCIETY'S ORPHEN broke slowly, was outrun down the backstretch and fell back through the stretch.
