MISS MATCH (ARG) chased outside a rival then briefly between foes five eighths out, continued a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch, angled in some in midstretch and rallied under left handed urging while angled out in deep stretch to get up on the wire. SWITCH stalked the pace off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter into and on the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched away in midstretch, kicked clear when ALWAYS A PRINCESS went wrong past midstretch, drifted in late and held on well but was caught on the line. VISION IN GOLD settled outside chasing the pace, moved up three deep on the backstretch then outside a rival into the second turn, came out into the stretch and finished willingly outside the top pair. ST TRINIANS (GB) pulled her way along to chase the pace inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. HEMERA settled off the rail, angled in on the first turn and saved ground to no avail. ALWAYS A PRINCESS had good early speed and set the pace inside under a rating hold, fought back on the second turn and into the stretch, took a bad step past midstretch and was pulled up, then fell nearing the wire and was vanned off.
