VIRGINIE (BRZ) saved ground, dropped back and steadied off heels midway on the second turn, was blocked behind rivals in midstretch, came out and gamely split foes in deep stretch, then surged late under left handed urging to get up at the wire. PLUS (CHI) settled three deep, went four wide on the second turn and into the stretch, gained a short lead in deep stretch and was caught on the line. CHAMPAGNE ROYAL, angled in and saved ground, came out leaving the backstretch, bid outside FINALLY in midstretch, gained a small advantage past the eighth pole but was overtaken. TAMISE, settled outside, went three deep between rivals on the second turn and lacked the needed late response. INCHACOOLEY (IRE) angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and put in a late bid. CURITIBA between rivals much of the way to the stretch, angled inward and waited momentarily in midstretch, the could not offer the needed late kick. FINALLY (AUS) took the early lead, dueled inside VOLUPIA, kicked clear on the second turn but weakened in the final furlong. VOLUPIA (ARG) forced the pace outside FINALLY to the second turn, dropped back on that bend and gave way.
