FREAKIN STREAKIN cut the corner at the right hand curve then chased outside, came four wide into the stretch and closed willingly under some urging to get up late. RATHER HAVE RUBIES had good early speed and set a pressured pace inside, kicked clear into the lane and held on gamely but was caught late. KISS'N DYNA bumped at the start, chased off the rail, split horses into the stretch, bid between foes in late stretch and continued gamely between foes. DYNALOOK chased outside then angled in leaving the hill, swung out into the stretch and found her best stride late. KALANI GIRL (IRE) a bit slow to begin, raced unhurried off the rail then angled to the inside on the hill, came out in upper stretch and put in a late bid four wide. REDMEANSGO pulled early, angled in and chased inside, continued along the rail in the stretch and lacked the needed response. ROMACA stalked between horses or outside a rival then angled to the inside on the hill, came off the rail in the stretch and did not rally. ANANDA PARADISA had speed between foes then stalked off the rail, continued outside a rival down the hill and weakened in the stretch. HISPANIOLA pulled early, forced the pace outside a rival, drifted wide on the dirt crossing and also weakened. MALDIVES chased inside, drifted out leaving the hill and wide into the stretch, continued near the outside fence in the lane and was eased late. Rail on hill at zero.
