SILENT SIGHs stalked outside a rival then off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter on the second turn and gained the lead, inched clear while drifting out some into the stretch, then drifted in through the drive but held gamely under some urging. HALFBRIDLED stalked inside then a bit off the rail, split rivals into the stretch, could not catch the winner but continued willingly for the place. A. P. ADVENTURE a bit wide into the first turn, stalked outside a rival, continued between horses on the second turn, was shuffled back some leaving that turn, found the inside in midstretch and gained the show. HOLLYWOOD STORY angled in approaching the first turn then came out into the backstretch, chased outside a foe, went three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch and was edged for third. STELLAR JAYNE wide into the first turn, settled off the inside, went four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. VENCEDORA AMIGA angled in and was unhurried along the inside, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. SALTY ROMANCE sped between horses to the early lead, set the pace inside, duelled inside the winner on the second turn and gave way in the stretch.
