Footnotes

FORTY PACES had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, kicked clear off the inside down the hill and held on gamely in the stretch under urging. EZ RACHEL squeezed a bit in the early going, settled off the rail, swung four wide into the stretch and rallied on the far outside to gain the place late. RUBY LANE chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out leaving the hill and three deep into the stretch and rallied between foes late. EMILY PEARL chased outside a rival, came out leaving the hill and four wide into the stretch and also rallied between horses late. LIFT OUR LUCK settled off the rail then angled in down the hill, came out into the stretch, split rivals in deep stretch and also continued willingly late. HOT TICKET stalked a bit off the rail then inside, split horses in midstretch and was outfinished. THE GREAT ATLANTIC stalked outside then alongside a rival down the hill, was between horses in deep stretch and weakened late. GOOD ACKTRESS between horses early, chased a bit off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, split foes in midstretch and lacked the needed late kick. SEACHI dueled inside the winner then stalked along the rail down the hill and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. Rail on hill at 7 feet.
