LEADING LIGHT settled along the inside, angled out leaving the turn, came three deep into the stretch, made the lead under some urging a sixteenth out and pulled clear, then held off UPTOWN SQUEEZE under steady handling. UPTOWN SQUEEZE stalked the pace a bit off the rail, lacked room off heels in midstretch, came out and surged late. TIPPYTOE CAT between rivals early, continued outside UPTOWN SQUEEZE, bid three deep into the stretch but could not match the top pair late. DOOR BELL dueled outside PACHIRA under restraint, took a short lead between foes in upper stretch, also could not match the top two and just lost third. PACHIRA sprinted up inside and dueled on a short lead to the stretch, fought back when headed but weakened some late. MAMAISON MISS three deep on the backstretch and outside KALOOKAN ANGEL on the turn, did not rally. KALOOKAN ANGEL broke slowly, went between rivals on the backstretch, angled in for the turn and had no response in the stretch.
