NAUTICAL LOOK hustled away from the gate and grabbed command while angling over to secure the rail, well rated on the lead and remained clear under urging. PRIZED PROSPECT bumped at the break, settled off the leaders, raced four wide around the final turn and into the stretch and finished very willingly. SASIN (IRE) taken in hand leaving the gate, came off the fence, later forced five wide around the final bend and into the lane and closed for the show. CHECK REALITY settled between foes to the final turn, checked in tight quarters nearing the quarter marker, then blocked in midstretch, swung out for room and finished full of run. SETAREH was hard to load, raced prominently on a three wide path to the stretch and failed to mount a late bid. FLEET SPARROW settled off the leaders a bit off the rail, caught four wide on the final turn and improved position. ARMITAGE broke slowest of all, unhurried through the early stages and never reached contention. ENCANTADO angled over a bit and led the second flight into the backstretch, loomed boldly nearing the top of the stretch but failed to sustain bid. VIRTUAL broke out and bumped with foe leaving the gate, raced a bit wide to the stretch, swung out for room in upper stretch but then lugged out severely through the lane and nearly made the outside fence. LA BELLA DONNA close up while saving ground for the opening half, but dropped back readily over the final quarter.
