Footnotes

GEORGIE BOY pulled his way into stalking position, remained slightly off the rail, awaited room entering the stretch, shifted out when roused, drifted inward under right hand urging, then steered back out in deep stretch, surged outside and shot past leader from outside. GAYEGO came off the fence and prompted the pace into the backstretch, advanced and engaged leader on second turn, gained slim advantage in the drive, drifted out some and was overhauled late. BOB BLACK JACK quickly sent to the front, rated from the inside, resisted on second turn when challenge, remained inside in the drive and only gave ground grudgingly late. INDIAN SUN was slow to begin, lagged back along the rail, swung out into the lane, later came back in some and finished strongly. CHOP HOUSE GEORGE settled off the rail, chased three then four wide to the stretch and lacked any late response. HIGH STAKES SILVER settled off the rail, stalked outside the winner into and around the second turn, could not go with that rival in upper stretch, drifted in some and weakened. SOUTHWEST unhurried inside, later caught four wide around the final bend, came out further leaving that bend and failed to threaten. SHEDIK (FR) hesitated and veered out at the start, chased on two wide path and was no factor. GO FOR COVER angled in and found the rail, continued inside and failed to reach contention.
