

## **Footnotes**

GALLANT SON patiently handled from along the rail, saved ground into second turn, shifted out four wide into the stretch, rallied strongly from the outside and was along in time. SMOKEY LONESOME stalked from between foes then three wide to final bend, rallied and bid from between rivals through the drive and was up gamely on the wire for second. WALL STREET WONDER quickly stepped to the front, controlled pace from along the rail, rebuffed rival in upper stretch, edged away, dug in in deep stretch but lost lead then second on the wire. LEEDSTHEWAY pulled his way to pressing position outside leader, moved up and bid outside that rival into the stretch, battled from between foes in the drive but gave ground grudgingly. COFFEE BAR settled outside foe, chased on two wide path into the stretch and finished very willingly. CAPE TRUTH stalked from along the fence, continued inside throughout and only yielded ground late. REMUS angled over, chased bit off the rail then inside, swung out five wide entering the stretch and failed to threaten. HULA KING (GER) was bit slow to begin, steered over early, saved ground into the stretch and lacked needed response. BALFOUR PARK lagged back early from along the rail, saved ground throughout but never menaced. HYPE four deep into the first turn, stalked outside and three wide into and around second turn, dropped back in upper stretch and faded.
