LAHCOTAH forced the early issue from between foes, dropped back bit on the turn and again between foes, angled out four wide into the stretch, rallied

under vigorous handling and won bob on the wire. ONLY BE CAUSE prominently placed from the outside, stalked four wide, moved up three wide, bid then grabbed slim advantage, dug in gamely late in the drive but was nailed. DOWNTOWN BANKER dueled from off the rail, gained slim lead then edged away, fought back when passed in the drive and battled gamely to the wire. MARCADE stalked from along the rail, chased two wide into the lane, came in bit late and rallied willingly. NEW YORK BABY also chased from the inside, remained on the rail, awaited room entering the stretch, later came off the fence and improved placing. ROGUE RIVER unhurried while taken to the inside, saved ground into the stretch, came out bit in the drive and finished well. SACCENTE was slow to begin, angled over early, chased two wide and lacked needed response. PEMBA AT U. T. K. forced the early pace from the inside, continued prominently leaving the turn then weakened. TODAY'S GOLD settled off the rail, chased three then four wide to the stretch and also weakened. CLASS DISMISSED came off the inside nearing the turn, chased three then four wide into the lane and was no late threat. DOMESTIC GOLD chased from off the rail then between foes, chased three wide around the turn and was no factor. DE BRIEF ME settled from between foes, chased bit off the rail then outside rival and weakened. GROUP EFFORT reserved from well off the fence, chased, four then five wide around the turn and also weakened.
