Footnotes

ADMISSION had speed between horses then stalked a bit off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter then took the lead between foes on the second turn, inched away a quarter mile out, shook off the bid of the runner-up under urging nearing midstretch, drifted in late and won clear. ALL SQUARED AWAY bobbled slightly at the start, went three deep into the first turn, then stalked outside a rival, bid three wide on the second turn then outside the winner in upper stretch, could not match that one thereafter but bested the rest. TINGALEO angled in on the first turn and stalked inside, went around a rival into the stretch, came out some and picked up the show. NOME saved ground chasing the pace, came out in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. MYHORSEOFCOURSE a step slow to begin, settled off the rail then outside a rival on the backstretch and second turn and could not summon the necessary response. TAKE NO PRISONERS sent inside then pulled a bit on the early lead, set the pace along the rail, fought back on the second turn but weakened in the stretch.
