TRUCIAL STATE angled in and chased inside, came out into the stretch, found the rail again nearing midstretch, came off the fence a sixteenth out and rallied under urging to nail the runner-up on the line. DANGEROUS DUO also angled in on the first turn and saved ground chasing the pace, slipped through inside to gain the lead in the stretch, kicked clear and held on well but was edged late. LANGFURS LIGHTNING pulled a bit and stalked inside, was between horses a quarter mile out, came three deep into the stretch and finished with interest. HAVA CIGAR allowed to settle off the pace inside, saved ground throughout and went on willingly along the fence. ANIMAUX DEL VIENTO unhurried outside a rival then a bit off the rail on the second turn, came out some in the stretch and improved position. ROCKET TRAIN pulled early, angled in on the first turn and settled off the pace, came out into the stretch and also improved position but was not a threat. I FEEL FREE angled in and chased outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TOMMY'S KID settled off the pace outside a rival, came out three deep into the stretch and was not a threat. VERY UNUSUAL sped to the early lead, drifted out into the first turn, angled in and set the pace inside, duled on the second turn, came off the rail into the stretch, was between foes in midstretch and weakened. OUR MERV (IRE) pulled between foes then stalked outside a rival or off the rail, bid alongside the

pacesetter and dueled on the second turn, was fanned out some into the stretch, continued three deep in midstretch and also weakened. GABBRO GLITZ wide early, angled in and stalked outside a rival, was three deep leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
