COULD BE TROUBLE tucked in behind dueling leaders, came out slightly on the turn, quickly advanced, reeled in leader, reached front approaching sixteenth marker and accelerated away under one left handed tap of the whip and hand pressure. A DROP DEAD DIVA rushed up from the inside then was taken off the rail to force the pace, grabbed command midway on the turn, edged away into the lane, continued inside but had little resistance for the winner. BOLLER BOMB chased from the inside early, angled out on the turn and came four wide into the stretch then was along for the show. O HAPPY GRAY unhurried while widest of all on the backstretch, chased five wide exiting the turn and improved placing from well off the rail. OUT OF THIN AIR showed good early foot from the inside, was overtaken midway on the turn and weakened from the inside. SPRING GAL stalked from the outside, caught three deep into the turn, remained on same path to the stretch and weakened. RUN CAPTIVE RUN broke in bit, stalked from between horses then outside eventual winner, also raced three wide into the lane and faded. TRIBAL RAIN chased from the inside throughout and gave way in the stretch.
