CHILOQUIN was bit crowded at the start, settled then chased from off the rail or outside foe, came four wide into the lane, responded when roused, surged under left handed urging and nailed leader in final strides. SWEET SWAP tracked pace from the outside down the hill, moved up and challenged three deep across the dirt portion, lugged inward in upper stretch then battled outside rival in the drive, gained slim advantage past sixteenth marker but could not hold the winner. BASMATI prompted the early issue then moved up to bid from between rivals nearing and on the dirt portion, battled inside gamely through the drive and only gave ground grudgingly approaching the wire. STARSPANGLED HEAT unhurried from off the rail, came out some entering the stretch, responded very willingly when roused and finished with a flourish from the outside. NO SILENT shifted over early and tracked leaders from the inside, came three wide into the stretch, was briefly inside winner past sixteenth marker then yielded. A TOAST TO YOU reserved while slightly off the fence, angled five wide entering the stretch, remained on the far outside and found his best stride late to improved placing. BIG NOTE (IRE) conceded pace to rivals early then was guided to the inside, stalked from along the rail down the hill then weakened. MASTER CHEF reserved from the inside, chased along the inside into and through the stretch but was outrun. D'PENDABLE broke in slightly but quickly recovered and sped to the front, set pace down the hill, resisted when challenged crossing the dirt, lost contact in the drive and faded. MAYBE TUESDAY was slow into stride and lagged back early, later came off the rail but never menaced.
