Footnotes

COMPLETE APPROVAL stalked the pace along the inside, came out into the stretch, gained a short advantage past the eighth pole and held on gamely. DELICIOSA (ARG) had speed to duel between horses then outside a rival down the hill, came out and fell back a bit into the stretch then came back on in the final furlong. COLOR ME SPECIAL settled outside on the hill, came six wide into the stretch and found her best stride late. PARTY PIRATE allowed to settle outside a rival down the hill, split rivals in deep stretch and put in a late bid toward the inside. ONE NUMBER SHORT chased between horses then off

the rail down the hill, came four wide into the stretch and was outfinished. TUTELADA (BRZ) unhurried off the inside down the hill, came out some in the stretch and improved position. SISSI SONG (FR) squeezed a bit at the start, chased toward the inside, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. LADY CADET went up inside to duel for the lead, inched away into the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. SAND PARTRIDGE (IRE) angled in and saved ground down the hill to no avail. BEL AIR BELLE off a bit awkwardly, settled off the rail down the hill, swung wide into the stretch, had the rider lose the whip late and was outrun. VERA ICY LADY cut the corner at the right hand curve then dueled three deep, stalked outside a foe leaving the hill and weakened. END TUNE was in a good position chasing outside down the hill, came five wide into the stretch and also weakened.
