Footnotes

ORIANA'S MAGIC saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch, then rallied to the front when the leader hit the rail in deep stretch. MISS TROPICS sped to the early lead, set a fast pace inside, dueled inside a rival on the turn, checked off that one's heels in deep stretch, then regained the place spot late. SOVEREIGN PRINCESS stalked three deep then outside a rival, bid outside the leader and dueled on the turn, took command into the stretch, inched away under left handed urging, lugged in under a right handed crack of the whip in deep stretch, hit the inner rail forty yards out, had the rider lose the right iron at that point but saved the show. QUATRRAIN was climbing a bit when off the rail early, angled in and advanced inside on the turn, steadied behind the show horse in deep stretch and lacked the needed response. SOPHISTICATEDBLUFF stalked between horses then a bit off the rail, went three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed late response. SECRET WILDCAT settled off the rail chasing the pace, split horses leaving the turn and did not rally. YOUNBETSHECAN broke in the air and slowly, angled in and saved ground but was outrun.
