### Footnotes

LATE DATE settled on three wide path into backstretch, advanced outside, caught four and five wide into the lane, gained lead, then edged away under strong handling. HIGHER LOVE between foes early, then found the rail early on the final turn, angled out, awaited room in upper stretch, came in bit, split foes then surged in the final sixteenth. BORN COMPETITIVE unhurried while crossing inward, saved ground to final bend, shifted back out, raced three wide into the stretch and finished strongly on the outside. STINGOFTRUTH bumped at the start, saved ground the opening half, chased between foes, then caught three wide leaving the final bend, rallied through the drive but lost the show at the wire. LOLLAPALOOZA was forced in some and bumped at the start, recovered and sped to the front, dictated the pace from the inside but weakened through the drive. EXCESSIVE CINDI caught three wide early, progressed off the rail then four wide around the second turn, challenged in upper stretch but failed to sustain effort. PRIZESSIN stalked outside foe into backstretch, moved up and bid three deep into and around the final turn and also weakened. THUNDER BEBE reserved from the inside, saved ground to the stretch and failed to rally. ORCADIA broke in a bit, stalked the pacesetter from the inside, then challenged from between rivals but had little left for the drive.
