Footnotes

POINT GIVEN broke inward, then content to settle off the early leaders, steadily advanced from outside, caught five wide leaving the backstretch, gained command around final bend, cleared then angled in a bit while kept to task to wire. I LOVE SILVER bumped in opening strides and a bit squeezed, angled to rail and was unhurried for opening half, responded when roused on final bend, swung out for room, rallied four wide into the lane and chased winner home willingly. JAMAICAN RUM lagged back while saving ground to second turn, rallied outside I LOVE SILVER, then forced five wide entering the stretch and finished full of run. BANK STREET set or forced the pace from along the fence while a bit rank early, remained prominent into the second bend but weakened. INDY LEAD bumped with foe in opening strides, unhurried while saving ground and failed to menace. SKIP TO THE STONE advanced steadily from the outside and bid four deep and inside POINT GIVEN leaving the backstretch but failed to sustain bid and weakened from inside. SILVERTONGUE FOX dueled outside rival early and between rivals into the final bend but weakened and gave way readily late. GOLD TRADER dueled three deep into the initial turn and remained prominent while three deep and between horses into the second then, then tired, taken to the inside, broke down and was vanned off.
