Footnotes

SCROFA unhurried a bit off the rail on the hill, moved up between horses into the stretch, waited off heels then bulled through bumping MINI SKIRT then the runner-up past midstretch and gamely prevailed under good handling. BLIND AMBITION stalked the pace inside then moved up along the rail to duel for the lead, drifted out a bit into the stretch, battled outside a rival in midstretch, bumped with the winner in deep stretch, could not quite match that one late but held second. OUR MANGO chased outside then three deep on the hill, came four wide into the stretch and gained the show late. BENEFICIAL BARTOK chased between horses, was bumped on the hill, bid three deep between foes leaving the hill and was edged for third late. TUCKED AWAY allowed to settle inside then a bit off the rail, swung out into the stretch and found her best stride late. RUN REBECCA RUN stalked off the rail then bid four wide down the hill but weakened in the stretch. MARKET GARDEN close up stalking the pace off the rail or between horses, was in tight when boxed in passing the eighth pole and outfinished. MINI SKIRT stalked between horses, was bumped and steadied on the hill, bid inside in the stretch and also was outkicked. DEPUTY TOMBE chased outside then alongside a rival, came out into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. THE USUAL chased between foes then inside and lacked the needed rally. FIVE STAR MEETING sped to the early lead off the rail, duelled between foes and was bumped leaving the hill, dropped back into the stretch and gave way. Rail on hill at 7 feet.
