Footnotes

NORVSKY chased between horses then outside a rival, came out on the second turn and six wide into the stretch, gained the lead outside foes past the eighth pole, drifted in some and inched away under left handed urging. TAMARACK SMARTY chased between horses then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, angled in leaving the second turn, lacked room behind rivals in midstretch, came out pat the eighth pole and gained the place three deep on the line. BRING IT HOME drifted off the rail into the first turn, angled in and stalked inside, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch, put a head in front between rivals in midstretch, fought back in deep stretch and was edged late for the place. LUCKY PRIMO stalked outside a rival, came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch, bid between foes in midstretch and was outfinished. SHEDIK (FR) pulled early, chased three deep, came out some in the stretch and also was outfinished. CONCERTO'S THUNDER bobbled at the start, was sent between horses then stalked outside a rival, came out into the stretch, and could not summon the needed late kick. WORTH REPEATING angled in and chased inside, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch, was boxed in between and behind rivals in midstretch, came out and lacked the needed rally. HIDDEN BLESSING close up stalking the pace inside, came out into the stretch, bid between horses in midstretch and weakened some late. CAT BRULAY stalked the pace off the rail then outside a rival leaving the second turn, bid between horses in the stretch, was in a bit tight in deep stretch and also weakened late. HEAVENLY WIND sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, fought back along the rail in the stretch, steadied briefly in a bit tight in deep stretch and weakened. EGYPT (GB) angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response.
