**Footnotes**

HOT CITIZEN bobbled a bit at the start but broke alertly, chased outside a rival or off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, rallied under urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. DISLITLETEOMINE settled off the inside, angled in some on the hill, swung out into the stretch and gained the place late. FAIRWAY ROAD went up inside a rival to the early lead, set the pace off the rail then inside, remained clear past midstretch, could not match the winner late and just lost second. NOTHING TO FEAR bumped and steadied between horses at the start, settled inside, came out in upper stretch and found her best stride late. GLORY PRIDE angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, split foes in a bit tight a sixteenth out and lacked the needed rally. LISA LULU chased outside a rival then inside down the hill and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. MILLIONDOLLARBILL had good early speed off the rail then stalked between horses, loomed a threat in midstretch but weakened in the final furlong. ROMAN CHARITY stalked four wide then three deep to the stretch and also weakened. GUIDED REWARD bumped at the start, settled inside chasing the pace, cut the corner into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
