Footnotes

FAST N FURIUS CAT forced the early issue from outside pacesetter into and on the turn, moved alongside that rival passing quarter marker, reached the front in upper stretch then pulled clear and safely held under urging. SIR ALLISON tracked leading duo from along the rail early, was eased off the fence on the turn, angled out further under left hand urging passing mid stretch then closed strongly in the late stages. SHAME ON ALEX was sent up inside to set the early pace, was pressured on the lead, briefly resisted departing the bend, lost contact pass eighth marker and then lost the place. SMOKEN LEGACY chased on two wide path early, continued inside, was hard asked for response on the turn, came out some in the lane, angled back in some and was no factor. PLENNY OF HENNY reserved early, shifted out approaching the turn, moved up rapidly on three wide path, continued off the rail and prominently into the stretch but flattened out. MR. WHY WHY chased either three wide or outside foe into the turn, remained off the rail and weakened.
