Footnotes

ROCK ME BABY showed good early foot, was closest in pursuit down the hill, continued bit off the rail, drifted out slightly into the lane, dropped back slightly then re-rallied under urging, wore down pacesetter in late stages, reached the front nearing the wire and just lasted. DIXIELAND BLUES settled off fast pace, chased while outside rival most of the way down the hill, hopped slightly hitting dirt portion, roused and responded strongly, closed furiously in the drive and just ran out of ground from between foes and inside the winner. KILAT blazed to clear advantage quickly, set uncontested pace down the hill, continued inside, responded when challenged entering the lane, re-established advantage, dug in late along the fence but could not stave off top pair. SHRED THE SECRETS was forwardly placed early, stalked while bit off the fence, drifted out slightly departing the hill and went willingly to the wire. PULPIT'S EXPRESS chased from along the inside down the hill and into the stretch, continued inside and finished strongly. SIZZLIN' JOE unhurried initially, raced along the inside, angled four wide entering the stretch and never menaced. CRIMSON GIANT lagged back early from off the rail, angled over, found the inside, and improved placing late from along the rail. TRIBE reserved while outside rival then between horses, drifted five wide departing the hill and

lacked needed response. HUSBAND'S FOLLY settled well off the pace and also off the rail, remained bit wide to the stretch and also never threatened. SUANCES CANDY was forwardly placed while shifting over, chased from along the rail, came out slightly in the stretch and weakened. KESSABTSI settled off the pace, chased three abreast, continued three wide then between horses and failed to reach contention. CHAMPIONS GATE unhurried from off the rail, raced three then four wide into the stretch and weakened. Rail at zero on the hill.
