WOODMAN'S PROSPECT advanced along the rail early on the turn, swung out for room, forced five wide into the stretch, then inhaled leaders late and drew clear. FORT DONNA dueled outside early, gained control while three wide around the turn, then cleared, angled inward through the drive and was overhauled. STARRER angled out and advanced three wide around the bend, loomed into the stretch, then angled inward in upper stretch, secured the rail, then caught in tight and forced to steady sharply nearing the wire. JOUET dueled early from between foes, then gained the rail but weakened. BLUE SKY BABY broke alertly and dueled early from the inside, saved ground but then weakened. ANGEL GIFT close up early while angling in some, raced two wide around the turn and outside the winner but failed to menace. DARLING LOVER squeezed, then checked and shuffled back in opening strides and never recovered. ARKAH was slow into stride, saved ground but to no avail. TIANNA ROAD dueled from between foes into the turn, dropped back and then gave way readily. Following a steward's inquiry involving the incident in deep stretch, FORT DONNA was disqualified and placed third for drifting in and causing interference.
