**Footnotes**

YOU I LOVE was sent up inside to grab early command, maintained slight cushion into the lane, responded when challenged passing midstretch and powered clear under brisk handling. WHY KNOTT ME TOO unhurried off the rail, launched rally three wide around the bend, drifted out further entering the stretch and found her best stride late from the outside. SHARI'S DELIGHT was off a step slow, chased three wide leaving the backstretch and remained on same path around the turn, drifted out further into the lane, loomed boldly nearing midstretch but failed to sustain effort and lost place. CRIMSON DELIGHT was off slow, chased well off the rail, then four wide into the bend, gradually angled to the rail but failed to threaten. AMAPOLA'S WISH prompted the early pace a bit off the fence, was two wide around the turn and into the lane, then weakened. JORDAN'S DOUBLE had a rail-hugging trip but gave way readily in the final quarter.
