SILBER broke out a bit, angled in and settled off the paced inside, came out into the stretch, split horses in midstretch and rallied under energetic handling to get up three deep on the line. HONOR SPIRIT stalked the pace outside a rival, went three deep with a bid on the second turn, gained a short lead outside the pacesetter past midstretch but was caught between foes late. MISS ALPHIE pulled her way to the early lead outside a rival, angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, fought back a bit off the rail in the stretch, drifted back to the fence past midstretch and continued willingly to the end. CELIA FATE angled in and saved ground, moved up inside on the backstretch, continued along the rail on the second turn and into the stretch, lacked room along the fence past midstretch, came out a bit and could not offer the necessary late response. AWESOME BEGINNING chased a bit off the rail then between foes, was shuffled back a bit on the backstretch, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch with a late bid. FUNNY COPY pulled her way along inside then a bit off the rail, chased between horses on the backstretch and outside a rival on the second turn, angled out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CLEVER JUNE stalked inside then a bit off the rail, bid between horses early on the second turn, continued just off the inside leaving that bend and weakened. JEWEL'S TIZZY settled three deep chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and also weakened.
