A. P. WARRIOR within striking distance while off the rail early, engaged leading pack four deep, continued on same path into the stretch, forged to the front and determinedly held under right hand urging. POINT DETERMINED prominent from along the rail, remained inside leaving final bend, came off the fence, rallied between foes, angled in some through the drive and narrowly missed inside winner. BOB AND JOHN bumped by outside rival at the start, reserved along the inside, angled out leaving the backstretch, caught five wide entering the stretch, loomed outside winner, then failed to sustain rally late and held the show. RACKETEER forced the early issue outside pacesetter, moved up and contested the pace between foes, later angled to the rail and gave ground grudgingly nearing the wire. REFINERY joined the leading pack while three deep, continued three wide around the final bend, angled in some, checked momentarily passing sixteenth marker and weakened some. NEW JOYSEY JEFF broke inward and bumped inside rival, unhurried while securing the rail, saved ground to the stretch and never reached contention. SIMON PURE flashed good early speed, crossed and the secured the front, controlled the early pace from the inside, resisted briefly into the final turn, then dropped back and gave way. BLAZING SUNSET checked off heels into the first turn, steadled again between rivals later on that turn, pulled his way between foes, in tight passing half-mile marker, then saved ground the second turn and weakened.
