XODO settled along the rail, saved ground chasing the pace, moved up some on the second turn, angled out into the lane, rallied, then split foes in deep stretch, collared leader and inched away. ATA BENCHMARK angled over the prompted the pace, moved up and challenged outside rival, gained lead, edged away in the drive but could not stave off winner late. THE FIREBIRD settled slightly off the rail, chased outside winner to second bend, came three wide into the stretch and gamely gained third. TROUBLETIMESTHREE three wide into first turn, came in some, later secured the rail, remained inside into stretch, shifted out passing sixteenth marker and just missed the show. HASTY TREND pulled himself very hard to the front, finally settled entering the backstretch, set the pace inside, briefly resisted but weakened in the drive. JOE CARL stalked while also saving ground to second turn and lacked needed late response. OVERTIME VICTORY settled slightly off the rail, also saved ground throughout and was no late factor. STREET ROYALE reserved early along the rail, came off the fence into the backstretch, chased three then four wide into the lane and was outrun.
